

Mark Oldfield

Mark Oldfield was born in Yorkshire and grew up in Suffolk. He studied at Colchester Institute, Guildhall School of Music and Drama, Britten-Pears School of Advanced Musical Studies and the Royal College of Music Opera School.

His versatile lyric baritone secured him an international career. Since his debut with Scottish Opera, Mark has sung roles with the Royal Opera Covent Garden, La Monnaie Brussels, Opera Northern Ireland, New Israeli Opera and Antwerp Opera in a repertoire that encompasses Mozart, Rossini, Britten and leading contemporary composers.

Mark has sung on tour in India, USA, Europe and the Middle and Far East, and has worked with leading directors and conductors who include Simon Callow and Sir Charles Mackerras.

Mark is an experienced concert singer having sung in the main concert halls and cathedrals of Britain in a repertoire that includes Bach, Brahms, Vaughan Williams, Britten and Will Todd. He has sung live on Classic FM and for royalty at the St James's and Kensington Palaces.
